Sub: Protocol for Transportation of Wild Animals- reg.

With a view to address the long-felt need for developing a protocol which would help in minimizing stress and injuries caused to the wild animals, especially deer during transportation, a National Workshop on "Protocol for the veterinary care and safety of the wild animals during transportation with special reference to deer species" was organized by Central Zoo Authority in collaboration of Madras Veterinary College, Chennai for zoo veterinarians from 24th-28th January 2011 at Chennai. After several deliberations, the draft guidelines have been recommended by the members of Technical Committee of CZA in their 59th Meeting held on 20th September 2011 for the approval of Ministry of Environment and Forests. Therefore, comments and suggestions are invited from the Civil Society, scientists, stakeholders and public at large until 20th December 2011 to enable further necessary action.
